EXECUTIVE

1. Executive Summary

AfriPact should be sold to institutions as a trusted reporting and response layer, not as a simple complaint form. The strongest value is that it gives leadership early visibility, structured workflow, evidence-backed reports, institution branding, AI-assisted triage, and aggregate insights.

- **For reporters:** a free, safe, and confidential way to report misconduct, abuse, corruption, security threats, and welfare concerns.
- **For institutions:** a controlled intake and response system that reduces blind spots, documents action, and supports safeguarding obligations.
- **For leadership:** anonymized analytics that reveal category, department, urgency, evidence, response-time, and unresolved-case trends.
- **For AfriPact:** a B2B revenue model through dashboard subscriptions, setup fees, AI, evidence storage, customization, training, and premium support.

CEO message

Do not lead with 'we help schools hide scandals.' Lead with responsible early resolution, student protection, due process, evidence quality, and reputation risk mitigation through proper systems.

2. Value Proposition To Institutions

Institution pain	AfriPact value	Business impact
Public call-outs and viral crises	A trusted internal pressure valve where students can report early and anonymously.	Protects institutional trust by giving leadership the first chance to respond responsibly.

REVENUE

3. Why Institutions Pay

Students and reporters should remain free. Institutions pay because AfriPact reduces operational risk and creates a repeatable governance system.

- **Subscription:** access to the admin dashboard, case workflow, evidence views, analytics, and institution-scoped reporting.
- **Setup fee:** configuration of institution profile, departments, roles, support contacts, policies, branding, and training.
- **Customization:** logo, response email, hotline, reporting statement, categories, forms, workflows, and subdomain.
- **AI add-on:** validation, rewriting, severity hints, missing-detail prompts, classification, and routing suggestions through the backend.
- **Evidence storage:** paid tiers for long videos, documents, PDFs, retention, and archive/export needs.
- **Training and workshops:** staff ethics, safeguarding, GBV response, campus security, student sensitization, and admin workflow training.
- **Premium support:** priority onboarding, reports, analytics review, managed triage assistance, and executive monthly summaries.

Recommended buyer personas

- Vice-Chancellor, Rector, Provost, Registrar, Dean of Student Affairs, Chief Security Officer, Legal/Compliance, Alumni/Advancement, ICT, Quality Assurance, HR, and Ethics Committee.
- For expansion: Ministry of Education, state agencies, donor programs, NGOs, security advisers, and public safety partners.

Implementation rule

Reporter privacy stays protected. Leadership analytics should be aggregate-first and must not reveal anonymous reporter identity.

PILOT

6. Recommended Pilot Offer

Start with a paid 60-90 day campus safety pilot. The goal is to prove adoption, report quality, admin workflow, and leadership value without over-customizing the product for one school.

- Branded institution dashboard with logo, response email, hotline, policy text, and escalation contacts.
- Mobile reporting for students and staff with optional anonymity and optional evidence uploads.
- Core categories: harassment, extortion, abuse, corruption, cultism/security, facilities, academic misconduct, and other welfare concerns.
- Monthly executive summary showing aggregate categories, unresolved cases, priority mix, evidence count, and response-time indicators.
- One launch workshop for staff and student representatives, plus one admin workflow training.
- Pilot success metrics: reports submitted, median time to first review, unresolved case load, category mix, evidence quality, and admin adoption.

One-line pitch

AfriPact helps people report safely and helps institutions respond responsibly, with evidence, workflow, analytics, and AI-assisted triage in one trusted platform.

Notes

AfriPact should avoid promising guaranteed emergency response, legal outcomes, or reputation suppression. The defensible claim is that it improves reporting, response coordination, evidence handling, analytics, safeguarding readiness, and accountability.
